I recently ordered and installed new needles and needle jets (and appropriate o-rings) in the carburetors of my '83 R100RT BMW. I've kept careful records of fuel consumption over the last 200,000 miles and over the last few years the bike has been consistent at 40-41 mpg for virtually all riding conditions. That has certainly changed and the first 500 miles with the new parts the bike has delivered a low of 46.7 mpg and a height of 50.9 mpg. I would not have believed it. The total mileage on the bike is 232,000 miles and other than putting alcohol resistant floats in place years ago the carbs are un-touched.

I noted when I disassembled the carburetors that one of the needles was in position 3 and one was in position 2. The carbs evidently left the BMW factory like that as I have not touched them prior to this parts change.

Just a quick note of thanks...I have been having difficulty getting my carbs serviced at the local dealer, so I turned to your manual. It turns out that cleaning, rebuilding, and setting up the carbs on my 1981 R100RT (original owner) is pretty easy with the manual. After making several trips to the dealer, and still not getting the carbs adjusted correctly, I used your manual to do it, and it was not difficult at all.

However, sometime later, I began to experience increased idle RPMs, and was afraid that I had not done such a good job after all. Again, I read the manual, and there I learned of the effect of air leaks. Inspecting downstream of the carbs, I found a cracked vacuum take off line. I snipped the last few mm of it, and reattached it. Went for a ride...fixed. It took me less time to read the manual and solve the problem than it would have taken just to ride to the dealer.
